4 3. The defendant 2005 Toyota 4-Runner Truck, VIN:

6 \$1,193.00 in U.S. Currency, and an Apple 16GB iPad, (hereafter
7 "defendant property") was seized in the city of Stockton, in San

2 a motion under Rule 12 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure
3 ("Fed. R. Civ. P.") must be filed and served within 20 days after
4 the filing of the claims and, in the absence thereof, default may
5 be entered and condemnation ordered.


