It appears that plaintiff has failed to comply with Local 18 19 Rule 183(b), which requires that a party appearing in propria persona inform the court of any 20 address change. The court notes that plaintiff previously provided a parole address of 1301 21 Yosemite Parkway, Merced CA 95340. ECF Nos. 118, 121. Plaintiff's subsequent filings bore a 22 different street address, 181 East 16th Street #9, Merced CA 95340. ECF Nos. 132, 133. Mail 23 delivered to the second address was returned on October 14, 2014, and October 28, 2014. The 24 court's review of the Inmate Locator website operated by the California Department of 25 Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) indicates that plaintiff may again be incarcerated, at California State Prison, Solano.¹ 26 27 See http://inmatelocator.cdcr.ca.gov/. This Court may take judicial notice of facts that are 28 (continued...) 1

1 Because more than sixty-three days have passed since the court's orders were returned, 2 and plaintiff has failed to notify the court of his current address, the court is authorized to dismiss this action without prejudice. See Local Rule 183(b).² Nevertheless, plaintiff will be accorded 3 4 one additional opportunity to inform the court of his current address of record, and his intent to 5 proceed with the instant action. The court will serve a copy of this order on plaintiff at each of 6 the above-noted addresses. 7 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 8 1. Plaintiff shall, within thirty days after the filing date of this order, inform the court of 9 his current address of record, and a statement of intent to proceed with this action. 10 2. Failure of plaintiff to timely comply with this order will result in the dismissal of this 11 action without prejudice. 12 3. Local Rule 183(b) provides: 23 24 A party appearing in propria persona shall keep the Court and 25 opposing parties advised as to his or her current address. If mail directed to a plaintiff in propria persona by the Clerk is returned by 26 the U.S. Postal Service, and if such plaintiff fails to notify the Court

and opposing parties within sixty-three (63) days thereafter of a

current address, the Court may dismiss the action without prejudice

for failure to prosecute.
