of law. Accordingly, the assignment of the matters to the same judge and magistrate judge is likely to effect a substantial savings of judicial effort and is also likely to be convenient for the parties.

The parties should be aware that relating the cases under Local Rule 123 merely has the result that the actions are assigned to the same judge and magistrate judge; no consolidation of the actions is effected. Under the regular practice of this court, related cases are generally assigned to the judge and magistrate judge to whom the first filed action was assigned.

## Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The action denominated 2:11-cv-2568-MCE-GGH, Ewing v. Donahue, be reassigned to Judge Garland E. Burrell, Jr., and Magistrate Judge John F. Moulds for all further proceedings;
- 2. Any dates currently set in this reassigned case only are hereby VACATED. Defendant in the reassigned case shall contact Judge Moulds's courtroom deputy, Jonathan Anderson, to reschedule the motion to dismiss before the undersigned;
- 3. An initial scheduling conference will be scheduled, as appropriate, following disposition of defendant's pending motion to dismiss for lack of jurisdiction;
- 4. Henceforth, the caption on documents filed in the reassigned case shall be shown as 2:11-cv-2568-GEB-JFM; and
- 5. The Clerk of the Court shall make appropriate adjustment in the assignment of civil cases to compensate for this reassignment.
