2 ECF No. 77-12.) According to plaintiff, challenged logging
3 activities are scheduled to commence on Monday, March 24, 2014.
4 (Dugan Decl. ¶¶ 2, 24, ECF No. 77-5.)

5 The court hereby orders as follows:


6 [1] Plaintiff's motion is SET for hearing on Wednesday,
7 March 19 at 3:30 p.m. in Courtroom 4. The court will vacate
8 this hearing if the parties file a stipulation agreeing to
9 submit the motion on the papers, or if they agree to a
10 stipulated TRO pending a hearing on a motion for preliminary
11 injunction.

13 [2] Defendant and defendant-intervenor are DIRECTED to file
14 their oppositions, if any, to the motion for a temporary
15 restraining order no later than Monday, March 17, 2014 at
16 4:30 p.m.

19 [3] Plaintiff is DIRECTED to serve defendant and defendant-
20 intervenor with a copy of this order forthwith and to file
21 notice of service with the court immediately thereafter.
