An evidentiary hearing is scheduled in this matter 18 19 on August 22, 2016, on petitioner's claim that her trial counsel rendered ineffective assistance 20 during the plea bargain process. 21 On July 29, 2016, petitioner filed a motion requesting permission to conduct the 22 deposition of Steve White, the state court judge who presided over petitioner's trial. After a 23 review of the motion, the court does not find good cause to order the discovery sought by 24 petitioner. The motion reflects that Judge White informed petitioner's current counsel that all of his communications with petitioner were in "open court, in the presence of all counsel and on the 25 26 record." ECF No. 79 at 3. Thus, whether or not petitioner was informed by the trial judge that
