Pursuant to 20 E.D. Local Rule 303(f), a magistrate judge's orders shall be upheld unless "clearly erroneous or 21 contrary to law." Id. Upon review of the entire file, the court finds that it does not appear that the 22 magistrate judge's ruling was clearly erroneous or contrary to law. An evidentiary hearing is 23 warranted based on the superior court's failure to consider and reject petitioner's declaration 24 regarding his request for a witness at his disciplinary hearing. 25 Therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, upon reconsideration, the order of the 26 magistrate judge filed August 29, 2013, is affirmed. 27 That opinion also included findings and recommendations which recommended that other 28 claims be denied. (ECF No. 37.) 1
