Currently pending before the court are numerous motions to dismiss plaintiff's fifth amended complaint, ECF Nos. 337, 338, 340, 341, 342, 343, 344, 345, 347; plaintiff's motion for default judgment against defendant Kimberly Merrifield, ECF No. 372; and defendant Merrifield's motion to set aside entry of default, ECF No. 375. These motions are currently set for hearing on January 7, 2015.

1 On December 10, 2014, plaintiff filed a request to continue the hearing on these motions,
2 ECF No. 373, explaining that it would difficult for her to travel to California to appear for the
3 hearing on January 7, 2015, due to her employment. She therefore requests that the matter be
4 continued to a later date.

5 In light of plaintiff's representations, it is hereby ORDERED that the January 7, 2015,
6 hearing is continued to February 4, 2015. Plaintiff shall file an opposition or statement of non-
7 opposition to defendants' motions to dismiss and Merrifield's motion to set aside entry of default
8 on or before January 21, 2015. Defendants' replies, if any, shall be filed by January 28, 2015.
