 20 This is an immigration case in which plaintiff has challenged the refusal to issue a visa to his
 21 fiancé. Since the filing of this lawsuit, the Department of State is in the process of returning the
 22 visa application to the Ho Chi Minh City post for further investigation. The parties therefore
 23 stipulate to a 90-day extension of time in which to file both the government’s answer to the
 24 complaint and the joint status report, as the parties explore the possibility of a resolution at the
 administrative level.

25 The parties therefore stipulate that the time for filing the government’s answer be extended to
 26 April 4, 2012, and that the scheduling conference, currently set for February 6, 2012, be reset to
 27 sometime after the new answer due date.
