1 **STIPULATION**

2 Appellants Scott Salyer, individually and as trustee of the Scott Salyer Revocable Trust,
3 SK PM Corp., SK Foods, LLC, SKF Canning, LLC, Blackstone Ranch Corporation, SKF
4 Aviation, LLC, Monterey Peninsula Farms, Salyer Management Company, LLC, SK Farms
5 Services, LLC, SK Frozen Foods, LLC, SS Farms, LLC, SSC Farming, LLC, SSC Farms I, LLC,
6 SSC Farms II, LLC, SSC Farms III, LLC, SKF Aviation, LLC and CSSS LP (collectively
7 “Appellants”), on the one hand, and Bradley D. Sharp (“Appellee”), the duly appointed and
8 acting chapter 11 trustee of substantively consolidated debtors SK Foods, L.P., a California
9 limited partnership, and RHM Industrial/Specialty Foods, Inc., a California corporation, on the
10 other hand, by and through their respective counsel, hereby stipulate and agree as follows:

11 1. On December 22, 2011, the Clerk of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the
12 Eastern District of California certified to the Court that the record in the above-captioned
13 bankruptcy appeal (the “Appeal”) was complete.

14 2. On the same day, the Clerk of the Court set the following briefing schedule:
15 Appellants’ opening brief and excerpts of record due January 5, 2012; Appellee’s opening brief
16 due within fourteen (14) days after service of Appellants’ brief, and Appellants’ reply due within
17 fourteen (14) days after service of Appellee’s brief. Dkt. No. 9-1, Dec. 16, 2011.

18 3. On January 2, 2012, Appellants filed an unopposed *ex parte* application to extend
19 the briefing schedule by 14 days.

20 4. On January 5, 2012, the Court granted the application and ordered Appellants’
21 opening brief to be filed by January 19, 2012.

22 5. Due to the press of business, Appellants’ counsel is unable to complete the
23 opening brief on Appeal by January 19, 2012. Accordingly, Appellants’ counsel requested that
24 Appellee stipulate to extend the briefing schedule an additional two weeks, making Appellants’
25 opening brief due February 2, 2012. Appellee’s counsel agreed.

26 6. Accordingly, the Parties respectfully request that the Court enter an order
27 extending the briefing deadline to February 2, 2012 and instructing that all other briefing

1 thereafter regarding the Appeal be conducted in accordance with the Local Rules and the
2 Bankruptcy Rules.
