20	On March 9, 2016, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein which	
21	were served on all parties and which contained notice to all parties that any objections to the

23	objections to the findings and recommendations. Defendants filed a reply.	
24	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304, this	
25	court has conducted a <u>de novo</u> review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the	
26	court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper	
27	analysis.	
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1	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
2	1. The findings and recommendations filed March 9, 2016, are adopted in full;
3	2. Defendants' motion for summary judgment (ECF No. 73) is denied as to plaintiff's
4	claim that defendant Colter retaliated against plaintiff on March 23, 2011, and granted in all other
5	respects; and
6	3. This matter is returned to the assigned magistrate judge for further scheduling.
