

1 No. 56. Pursuant to the Parties' stipulation,
2 on December 31, 2014[,] the Court entered an
3 Order Dismissing the Claims of the State of
4 California, in which *inter alia*, the claims
5 of Relators were dismissed "except as
6 otherwise provided in the Agreement." See ECF
7 No. 59. The Agreement specifically provides,
8 *inter alia*, that Relators do not release "any
9 claims to entitlement under Cal. Gov't Code §
10 12652(g) to a share of the proceeds of this
11 Settlement Agreement." Agreement at ¶ 4. The
12 State of California and Relators have reached
13 an agreement in principle regarding Relators'
14 share of the proceeds of the settlement with
15 the State of California but have not yet
16 finalized that agreement. **Other than the
17 issue of Relators' share of the proceeds of
18 the settlement with the State of California,
19 Relators and the State of California both
20 agree to the case being closed. The Relators
21 have already resolved their relators' share
22 claims with the United States, San Bernardino
23 County, and Santa Clara County.**

13 Accordingly, in order to provide the
14 parties' time to finalize their agreement
15 regarding Relators' share of the State
16 settlement, **Relators and the State of
17 California respectfully request that the
18 Court enter an Order to the effect that this
19 action will be closed as of May 1, 2015
20 unless Relators or the State of California
21 request otherwise prior to that date.**

18 Iron Mountain has indicated to relators'
19 counsel that it consents to this request.

20 Counsel for the County of San Diego has
21 also indicated the following to relators'
22 counsel: With the understanding that none of
23 the orders of dismissal entered in this
24 matter dismisses with prejudice any claims of
25 the County of San Diego, the County of San
26 Diego has no objection to the closing of this
27 case.

24 (Joint Status Report, ECF No. 64 (emphasis added).)

25 Based on the parties' representations concerning the
26 matters that remain to be resolved and the anticipated timing to
27 do so, a dispositional document shall be filed no later than May
28 1, 2015. Failure to respond by this deadline may be construed as

1 consent to dismissal of this action without prejudice, and a
2 dismissal order could be filed. See E.D. Cal. R. 160(b) ("A
3 failure to file dispositional papers on the date prescribed by
4 the Court may be grounds for sanctions.").


