21	Local Rule 303(b) states that "[r]ulings by Magistrate Judges shall be final if no

23	of the ruling on the parties." Id. Because Plaintiff's Motion for Reconsideration was not filed	
24	within fourteen days of the magistrate judge's September 22, 2014, Order, the Motion for	
25	Reconsideration is untimely and the magistrate judge's Order is final.
