On December 11, 2012, the court ordered defendant, within 30 days, to respond to plaintiff's October 19, 2012 pleading, in which plaintiff alleged that his file for this case had been removed from his cell. 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1 Accordingly, the court orders that defendant respond to the December 11, 2012
2 order to show cause, ECF No. 23, within five (5) business days of the filing date of this order.
3 Defendant's failure to file a response shall result in sanctions.
