The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 18 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 19 On June 25, 2012, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations (ECF No. 62) herein which were served on all parties and which contained notice to all parties that any 20 21 objections to the findings and recommendations were to be filed within twenty-one days. On 22 July 20, 2012, Plaintiff was granted an additional thirty days in which to file objections. (ECF 23 No. 70.) Thirty days have now passed, and no party has filed objections to the findings and recommendations. 24 25 /// 26 ///
