(ECF No. 30.) On November 10, 2014, Petitioner filed a Motion for Certificate of Appealability (ECF No. 32), as well as a Notice of Appeal to the Court of Appeals (ECF No. 33). 17 18 Under Ninth Circuit Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 22-1(d), "[i]f the district court denies a 19 COA as to all issues, petitioner may file a motion for a COA in the court of appeals....[i]f 20 petitioner does not file a COA motion ... the court of appeals will deem the notice of appeal to 21 constitute a motion for a COA." Because Petitioner filed an appeal with the Ninth Circuit Court 22 of Appeals on November 10, 2014, his appeal is considered a motion for a COA with the Court of Appeals and his motion before this Court is therefore moot.
