APPLICATION AND ORDER FOR PUBLICATION¹

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 19 The United States of America, Plaintiff herein, applies for an order of
 20 publication as follows:

21 1. Rule G(4) of the Supplemental Rules for Admiralty or Maritime Claims and
 22 Asset Forfeiture Actions (hereafter "Supplemental Rules") provides that the Plaintiff
 23 shall cause public notice of the action to be given in a newspaper of general circulation
 24 or on the official internet government forfeiture site;

25 2. Local Rule 171, Eastern District of California, provides that the Court shall
 26 designate by order the appropriate newspaper or other vehicle for publication;

1 3. The defendant property is located in the city of Nevada City, Nevada County,
2 California;

3 4. Plaintiff proposes that publication be made as follows:

- 4 a. One publication;
- 5 b. Thirty (30) consecutive days;
- 6 c. On the official internet government forfeiture
7 site www.forfeiture.gov;
- 8 d. The publication is to include the following:
 - 9 (1) The Court and case number of the action;
 - 10 (2) The date of the seizure/posting;
 - 11 (3) The identity and/or description of the property seized/posted;
 - 12 (4) The name and address of the attorney for the Plaintiff;
 - 13 (5) A statement that claims of persons entitled to possession or
14 claiming an interest pursuant to Supplemental Rule G(5) must be filed with the Court
15 and served on the attorney for the Plaintiff no later than 60 days after the first day of
16 publication on the official internet government forfeiture site; and
 - 17 (6) A statement that answers to the Complaint or a motion
18 under Rule 12 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure ("Fed. R. Civ. P.") must be filed
19 and served within 21 days after the filing of the claims and, in the absence thereof,
20 default may be entered and condemnation ordered.
