Despite an extension of time granted to plaintiff, neither party has filed objections to the findings and recommendations. 24 25 The court has reviewed the file and finds the findings and recommendations to be 26 supported by the record and by the magistrate judge's analysis. Accordingly, IT IS 27 **HEREBY ORDERED that:** 28 ///1
