Upon 20 review of the motion and the documents in support and opposition, upon hearing the arguments of 21 counsel and for good cause appearing therefore as set forth on the record at the hearing, IT IS 22 HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS: 23 1. This action is stayed for sixty days from the date of this order. 24 2. During the sixty day period of the stay, petitioner's counsel shall keep the court apprised of any legal developments that would justify a lifting of the stay. In addition, if the stay 25 26 has not been lifted, before the sixty day period of the stay expires, petitioner's counsel shall notify 27 the court and opposing counsel of the then-current status of the petitions pending before the U.S.

Supreme Court that were discussed at the hearing.

1	3. After the stay is lifted, the parties shall file a proposed schedule for the filing of a
2	traverse and any further briefing addressing the applicability of the decisions in Miller v.
3	Alabama, U.S, 132 S. Ct. 2455 (2012) and <u>Bell v. Uribe</u> , 729 F.3d 1052 (9th Cir. 2013)
4	to this case.
