During the sixty day period of the stay, petitioner's counsel shall keep the court 24 apprised of any legal developments that would justify a lifting of the stay. In addition, if the stay 25 26 has not been lifted before the sixty day period of the stay expires, petitioner's counsel shall notify

the court and opposing counsel of the then-current status of the petition for certiorari filed in

DeMola v. Cavazos, Acting Warden, 13-10288.
