Plaintiff Burch Bowen is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis in this  
civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983.

On August 6, 2012, Mr. Bowen filed a motion for appointment of counsel pursuant to 28  
U.S.C. § 1915(e)(1). Dkt. # 9. The court grants plaintiff's motion for appointment of counsel for  
the limited purpose of drafting and filing an amended complaint. Gregory P. Wayland has been  
selected from the court's pro bono attorney panel to represent plaintiff and he has agreed to be  
appointed.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Gregory P. Wayland is appointed as limited purpose counsel in the above  
entitled matter. This appointment is for the limited purpose of drafting and filing an amended  
complaint.
