16	Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis who seeks		
17	relief pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983.		
18	By order filed September 25, 2012, the court determined that plaintiff had stated a		
19	colorable claims against defendants Cook and Akintola, but not against defendant Weinholdt.		
20	See Doc. No. 7. The court accordingly dismissed the complaint with leave to amend, in order to		
21	give plaintiff an opportunity to amend his claims against defendant Weinholdt. <u>Id.</u> The court		
22	specifically advised plaintiff that, if he failed to file an amended complaint, the action would		
23	proceed only against defendants Cook and Akintola. Id. To date, plaintiff has not filed an		
24	amended complaint.		
25	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Clerk assign a district judge to

IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that defendant Weinholdt be dismissed from this action without prejudice. See Local Rule 110; Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b).

Within fourteen days after being served with these findings and recommendations, any party may file written objections with the court and serve a copy on all parties. The parties are advised that failure to file objections within the specified time may waive the right to appeal the District Court's order. Martinez v. Ylst, 951 F.2d 1153 (9th Cir. 1991).
