Judgment was entered in this action on November 4, 2013. On March 3, 2014, 19 plaintiff filed a notice of appeal. On the same day, he filed a request to proceed in forma pauperis 20 on appeal. Rule 24(a) of the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure provides that a party to a 21 district court action who desires to proceed in forma pauperis on appeal must file a motion in the 22 district court which: 23 (A) shows in the detail prescribed by Form 4 of the Appendix of Forms the party's 24 inability to pay or to give security for fees and costs; 25 (B) claims an entitlement to redress; and 26 (C) states the issues that the party intends to present on appeal. Fed. R. App. P. 24(a)(1). Plaintiff's motion fails to satisfy all three requirements. 27 28 ///// 1
