18	On April 8, 2013, Defendant filed a "Notice of Related Cases"
19	in which it states:
20	The cases arise out of the same underlying car accident and have overlapping questions of fact and
21	law. Plaintiff Herbert Brown was the passenger in the car driven by Plaintiff Charles Lewis. The
22	United States is the sole defendant in both cases. The Court granted the parties' request for the same
23	pretrial and trial schedule. The assignment of both cases to the same District Judge and Magistrate
24	Judge is likely to effect a substantial savings of judicial effort and significantly reduce the
25	potential for inconsistent results.
26	(ECF No. 16, 1:25-2:2.)
27	Examination of the above-entitled actions reveals they are
28	related within the meaning of Local Rule 123. Under the regular practice

of this Court, related cases are generally assigned to the judge and magistrate judge to whom the first filed action was assigned. Therefore, action 2:12-cv-03069 is reassigned to Judge Garland E. Burrell, Jr., and Magistrate Judge Carolyn K. Delaney for all further proceedings. Henceforth, the caption on documents filed in the reassigned case shall show the initials "GEB-CKD." Further, the Status Order previously issued in action 2:12-cv-03069 (ECF No. 10), before the action was reassigned to Judge Troy L. Nunley due to his appointment, remains fully effective.

10The Clerk of the Court shall make appropriate adjustment in11the assignment of civil cases to compensate for this reassignment.
