ORDER

On March 4, 2013, the parties filed a notice of settlement indicating that they have reached a private settlement of the matter, and that upon completion of a final, written settlement agreement, the parties will file a stipulation of dismissal pursuant to Rule 41(a)(1)(A)(ii) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.¹ (Dkt. No. 32.) The parties anticipate filing the stipulation of dismissal on or before April 28, 2013 (which falls on a Sunday). (Id.)

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:


- 1. Any scheduled dates in this action are VACATED.

¹ Although the parties indicate that they will also submit a proposed order, this is unnecessary, because a stipulation of dismissal signed by all parties who have appeared effectively dismisses the action without a court order. See Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A)(ii).

1 2. The parties shall file dispositional documents, including any stipulation of
2 dismissal pursuant to Rule 41(a)(1)(A)(ii), no later than April 29, 2013. Failure to file
3 dispositional documents by that deadline, or to file a timely request for an extension of that
4 deadline supported by good cause, may result in dismissal of the action without prejudice. See
5 E.D. Cal. L.R. 160(b).

6 IT IS SO ORDERED.
