 25 Plaintiffs June Riddick, Patricia Hardy, Natalie Maderos, and Valerie Lynn  
 26 (“Plaintiffs”) and Defendant YP ADVERTISING & PUBLISHING LLC (“YP”) by  
 27 and through their undersigned counsel of record, here by stipulate, and by this  
 28 Stipulation request the Court's approval, to the following:

1           1. All parties are very pleased the Court is taking the time to give serious

21 but do so in the interests of justice, to allow the Court to continue to give the  
22 parties' pending motions full and deliberate consideration, without risking undue  
23 prejudice to any party.


**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED**
