16	Plaintiff is a state prisoner represented by court-appointed counsel Michael C. Wood,	
17	Rachel Muoio, and Stephanie Albrecht, and is proceeding with a civil rights action pursuant to 42	
18	U.S.C. § 1983. Communication between Mr. Wood, Ms. Muoio, Ms. Albrecht, and their client is	
19	required to conclude the disposition of this case. By this order, the court directs the Warden and	
20	the correctional staff at California State Prison, Corcoran (COR), to facilitate a confidential	
21	telephone call between appointed counsel Mr. Wood, Ms. Muoio, Ms. Albrecht, and inmate	
22	Lamont Crossley (K-82991).	
23	In accordance with the above, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:	
24	1. The Warden, Litigation Coordinat	tor, and other correctional staff as needed at COR,
25	shall facilitate a confidential telephone call between inmate Lamont Crossley (K-	
26	82991) and appointed counsel.	
27	2. The confidential telephone call shall be placed on Monday, October 16, 2017, to

1	begin at 9:00 a.m . and shall continue, without interruption, for a maximum of 60	
2	minutes or until completed, whichever is earlier. Correctional staff shall initiate the	
3	phone call by calling Mr. Wood, Ms. Muoio, and Ms. Albrecht at (916) 329-7906.	
4	3. The telephone conversation shall be a confidential communication between appointed	
5	counsel and client and conducted so as not to be overheard by correctional staff or	
6	others. Correctional staff, however, may keep inmate Crossley under visual	
7	surveillance during the conversation.	
8	4. Failure to comply with this order may result in an order requiring the Warden of COR,	
9	or others responsible for the failure to comply, to appear before the court to show	
10	cause why sanctions should not be imposed against them.	
11	5. The Clerk of the Court is ordered to serve this order by facsimile (559) 992-7372 and	
12	email on the Warden and Litigation Coordinator at COR.
