10	moved to March 19, 2015.		
11	• That the Joint Pretrial Statement currently due November 26, 2014 be due to April		
12	29, 2015.		
13	• That the Final Pretrial Conference currently set for December 18, 2014 at 2:00pm be		
14	moved to May 21, 2015.		
15	• That the deadline to file any trial briefs, currently set for December 4, 2014, be		
16	moved to May 7, 2015.		
17	• That the deadline to file any evidentiary or procedural motions, currently set for		
18	November 26, 2014, be moved to April 29, 2015.		
19	• That the deadline to file an opposition to any evidentiary or procedural motion,

2	time consuming and problematic in part due to language and cognitive obstacles, an		
3	unusually high number of medical treating professionals (many of whose treatment of the		
4	plaintiff is ongoing and most of whom are in the Northern District), issues regarding <i>Touhy</i>		
5	compliance, and various discovery disputes which, although not acrimonious, have reached		
6	loggerheads and which have further slowed the process.
