Palma appeared on behalf of the 21 defendants. 22 Upon consideration of the arguments on file and at the hearing, and for the reasons set forth on the record at the hearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 23 1. Plaintiff's motion to compel responses to interrogatories (Dkt. No. 44) is 24 25 granted as modified on the record; 26 2. On or before July 11, 2014, defendants shall produce to plaintiff records of 27 phone calls placed on the requested defendants' personal cell phones relating to the incident that 28 is the subject of this action from the moment the incident began until midnight that same day; 1

1	3. Defendants may redact all information related to any calls not relevant to the
2	incident at issue and may redact unnecessary information as to relevant calls so long as the
3	receiver of the call is identified; and
4	4. Within seven days of the date of this order, defendants shall advise the court the
5	date upon which the Office of the Attorney General first received the Form 268 placed at issue by
6	plaintiff's motion to compel and which has been submitted to the court has for in camera review.
