ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Petitioner is a state prisoner proceeding pro se with a petition pursuant to 28 U.S.C. Section 2254. On November 16, 2012, respondent filed a motion to dismiss. After receiving no opposition, the court ordered respondent to re-serve petitioner with the motion at his proper address of record. On January 10, 2013, respondent filed a declaration of service. Petitioner has not filed an opposition to the motion. Local Rule 230(l) provides in part: "Failure of the responding party to file written opposition or to file a statement of no opposition may be deemed a waiver of any opposition to the granting of the motion"

Good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The Clerk shall assign a district judge to this case; and
2. Petitioner shall show cause, within thirty days, why his failure to oppose respondent's November 16, 2012 motion to dismiss should not be deemed a waiver of any

1 opposition to the granting of the motion, and he shall file an opposition. Petitioner is cautioned
2 that failure to respond to the instant order, or to file an opposition to the pending motion to
3 dismiss, will result in a recommendation that this action be dismissed.
