18	under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to		
19	28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.		
20	On April 13, 2017, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein, which		
21	were served on all parties and which contained notice to all parties that any objections to the		
22	findings and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. Neither party has filed		
23	objections to the findings and recommendations.		
24	The Court has reviewed the file and finds the findings and recommendations to be		
25	supported by the record and by the magistrate judge's analysis. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY		
26	ORDERED that:		
27	1. The findings and recommendations filed April 13, 2107 (ECF No. 53) are adopted in

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1	2. Plaintiff's motions for an extension of time (ECF Nos. 51, 52) are denied;	
2	3. This case is stayed until Plaintiff completes his program at California Health Care	
3	Facility ("CHCF") and regains access to his legal property and a law library;	
4	4. Defendant's December 16, 2016 motion for summary judgment (ECF No. 47) is denied	
5	without prejudice to its renewal when the stay is lifted and the case re-opened;	
6	5. Plaintiff shall inform the Court when he completes his program at CHCF and regains	
7	access to his legal property and a law library; and	
8	6. The Clerk of the Court shall administratively close this case.
