This matter is before the court on plaintiff, Helen Whelan’s (“plaintiff”), motion to consolidate this case with case number 2:09-v-cv-03606 KJM-CKD, which plaintiff filed on September 13, 2012. (Mot. to Consolidate, ECF 6.) Plaintiff maintains consolidation is appropriate because “[p]laintiff in each action asserts substantially the same claims and raises substantially the same question of fact or law.” (*Id.* at 2:10-12.)
