Accordingly, counsel shall submit a declaration, under seal, making the required showing, no later than July 21, 2014 at 4:30
p.m. Counsel shall also file a declaration in the public record establishing that the firm has complied with Cal. R. Prof.

Conduct § 3-700(D) (regarding client files and retainer agreement funds), or what steps it has taken to comply. ${ }^{1}$
