ORDER

Petitioner, a state prisoner proceeding through counsel, has filed a petition for a writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254.¹ On March 12, 2014, the court granted petitioner's motion for a stay and abeyance and directed petitioner to present all of his unexhausted claims to the California Supreme Court in a state habeas corpus petition to be filed within thirty days. The court also directed petitioner to file and serve a status report in this case on the first court day of each month. Petitioner has not filed a status report for the months of April or May of this year.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that petitioner shall file a status report explaining the current status of his exhaustion petition in state court within ten days of the date of
