**APPLICATION AND ORDER  
FOR PUBLICATION**

23 The United States of America, Plaintiff herein, applies for an order of  
24 publication as follows:

25 1. Rule G(4) of the Supplemental Rules for Admiralty or Maritime Claims  
26 and Asset Forfeiture Actions (hereafter "Supplemental Rules") provides that the  
27 Plaintiff shall cause public notice of the action to be given in a newspaper of general  
28 circulation or on the official internet government forfeiture site;

1           2.     Local Rule 171, Eastern District of California, provides that the Court  
2 shall designate by order the appropriate newspaper or other vehicle for publication;

3           3.     The defendant real property is located in Loomis, California, Placer  
4 County, and the defendant Approximately \$45,976.42 in U.S. Currency seized from  
5 Mechanics Bank Checking Account Number 41143841, held in the name of Teresa  
6 Rudd, dba Rock Bottom Beds was seized on August 7, 2012 in Sacramento, in

21 publication on the official internet government forfeiture site; and

22               (6)    A statement that answers to the Complaint or a motion  
23 under Rule 12 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure ("Fed. R. Civ. P.") must

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1 be filed and served within 21 days after the filing of the claims and, in the absence  
2 thereof, default may be entered and condemnation ordered.
