20 The parties, through their undersigned counsel, subject to the approval of the Court as provided
21 for hereon, recite and stipulate as follows:

22 RECITALS

23 1. Defendants filed dispositive motions on August 6, 2013. Plaintiff opposed and filed a
24 motion to amend the complaint on November 4, 2013. By Minutes filed November 14, 2013, the Court
25 *sua sponte* reset the hearing from December 16 to December 30, 2013, with no change to the December
26 2 date for defendants' replies for dismissal and summary judgment and defendants' opposition to
27 amendment.

28 2. Defense counsel needs additional time to communicate with agency counsel, prepare and

1 finalize supplemental declarations, and write and obtain and respond to internal review of the reply and
2 opposition papers.

3 3. No previous extension of this time has been sought or granted.

4 STIPULATION

5 4. That defendants' time to reply to plaintiff's oppositions to defendants' dispositive motions
6 filed August 6, 2013, set by Order filed October 2, 2013, and defendants' time to oppose plaintiff's
7 motion to amend filed November 4, 2013, be EXTENDED from December 2, 2013, until December 16,
8 2013.
