ORDERED that the Plaintiff's Motion is granted, and the United States Marshal shall transfer custody of the M/V SIDER PINK, immediately following her attachment and seizure, to the custody of the substitute custodian, NATIONAL MARITIME SERVICES (hereinafter "National"), by and through its authorized representatives, of 1915 SW 21st Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33312; and it is further

ORDERED that upon transfer of the M/V SIDER PINK to the substitute custodian, the aforesaid substitute custodian shall be appointed to act as substitute custodian of the M/V SIDER PINK during custodia legis on behalf of this Court, in place and instead of the United States Marshal, until written notice of release has been given by the Plaintiff to the United States Marshal or has been ordered by this Court; and it is further

ORDERED that upon transfer of the M/V SIDER PINK to the substitute custodian by the United States Marshal, the United States Marshal shall not be liable for any loss occurring while she remains in the custody of the substitute custodian; and it is further

ORDERED that after the M/V SIDER PINK is attached, the substitute custodian shall cause and be responsible to have the M/V SIDER PINK remain at an appropriate berth and/or anchorage within the Eastern District of California.

ORDERED that during *custodia legis*, the substitute custodian, National, will permit the vessel to undergo normal cargo operations, both loading and discharge, shift berths within the Eastern District of California, and/or undergo repairs, but always at the risk and expense of the vessel's interests.
