The United States Supreme Court has 17 ruled that district courts lack authority to require counsel to represent indigent prisoners in § 1983 cases. Mallard v. United States Dist. Court, 490 U.S. 296, 298 (1989). In certain exceptional 18 19 circumstances, the court may request the voluntary assistance of counsel pursuant to 28 U.S.C. 20 § 1915(e)(1). Terrell v. Brewer, 935 F.2d 1015, 1017 (9th Cir. 1991); Wood v. Housewright, 900 21 F.2d 1332, 1335-36 (9th Cir. 1990). In the present case, the court does not find the required 22 exceptional circumstances. Plaintiff's request for the appointment of counsel will therefore be 23 denied.
