18 League's notice of related cases, filed pursuant to Eastern
19 District of California Local Rule 123(b) (2013). Pl's Not., ECF
20 No. 503. Plaintiff requests that two cases, South Yuba River
21 Citizens League, et al. v. National Marine Fisheries Service, et
22 al., Case No. 2:13-cv-00059 MCE-EFB; as well as Yuba County Water
23 Agency v. National Marine Fisheries Service, No. 2:13-cv-00042-MCE-
24 CKD, be related to South Yuba River Citizens League, et al. v.
25 National Marine Fisheries Service, et al., 2:06-cv-2845 LKK-JFM.

1 Eastern District of California Local Rule 123(a) provides that
2 an action is related to another action when:

3 (1) both actions involve the same parties and are
4 based on the same or a similar claim;

5 (2) both actions involve the same property,
6 transaction, or event;

7 (3) both actions involve similar questions of fact
8 and the same question of law and their assignment
9 to the same Judge or Magistrate Judge is likely to
10 effect a substantial savings of judicial effort,
11 either because the same result should follow in
12 both actions or otherwise; or

13 (4) for any other reasons, it would entail
14 substantial duplication of labor if the actions
15 were heard by different Judges or Magistrate
16 Judges.

18 The court finds that South Yuba River Citizens League, et al.
19 v. National Marine Fisheries Service, et al., case no. 2:06-cv-2845
20 LKK-JFM is not sufficiently related to South Yuba River Citizens
21 League, et al. v. National Marine Fisheries Service, et al., Case
22 No. 2:13-cv-00059 MCE-EFB and Yuba County Water Agency v. National
23 Marine Fisheries Service, No. 2:13-cv-00042-MCE-CKD. Reassignment
24 of the two pending actions to the undersigned is not likely to
25 effect a savings of judicial effort or other economies.

26 The court, therefore, DECLINES to relate the cases.
