25	undersigned serving as the settlement judge, waiving any conflict that may arise as a result.		
26	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that within fourteen days of the filing of this		
27	order, the parties shall each file a signed Notice Regarding Waiver of Disqualification, indicating		
28	whether or not they agree to the undersigned serving as the settlement judge. Failure of either

1	party to file a waiver will result in this case being randomly assigned to another magistrate judge	
2	for purposes of conducting a settlement conference. Further instructions will issue once a	
3	settlement judge is assigned.
