20	Amendment claims: against defendant Kuppinger on plaintiff's excessive force claim, and against	
21	defendant Moore on plaintiff's failure to protect claim. See Findings and Recommendations filed	
22	Sept. 6, 2017, ECF No. 11, and Order Adopting Findings and Recommendations filed October	
23	20, 2017, ECF No. 113 (granting in part defendants' motion for summary judgment).	
24	On January 9, 2018, the parties participated in a mediation conference but the case did not	
25	settle. <u>See</u> ECF No. 119.	
26	To facilitate the scheduling of this case for pretrial and trial proceedings, it is necessary	
27	that the parties inform the court of certain matters.	
28	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDE	RED that, on or before Wednesday, February 28,
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1	2018, the parties shall file and serve separate statements that inform the court of the following:	
2	1. The anticipated length of trial; and	
3	2. Any dates through 2018 when any party may not be available for pretrial or trial	
4	proceedings.	
5	Upon review of the parties' respective statements, the court will issue an order that further	
6	schedules this action, including deadlines for filing pretrial statements that address the matters set	
7	forth in Local Rule 281(b).
