5	case dismissed; ¹		
6	4. Defendant's motions to strike various of plaintiff's fillings (ECF No. 22, 27, 28) are		
7	denied as moot in light of plaintiff's notice of withdrawal of his opposition to defendants' motion		
8	to revoke IFP status (ECF No. 31).
