2	under the Rehabilitation Act are dismissed for lack of subject matter jurisdiction;	
3	4. Plaintiff is granted thirty days to file an amended complaint that does not include the	
4	claims dismissed for lack of subject matter jurisdiction. Each allegation in the First Amended	
5	Complaint shall be separately numbered in accordance with Federal Rule of Civil Procedure	
6	10(b); and	
7	5. Defendant is granted thirty days to respond to the First Amended Complaint.
