17	Wells Fargo removed this case from the Superior Court of the	
18	State of California in the County of	Solano, asserting federal subject
19	matter jurisdiction based on diversity of citizenship under 28 U.S.C. §	
20	1332. (ECF No. 1.) Wells Fargo states in its Notice of Removal that	
21	Plaintiff "is a citizen of California based on domicile" and that Wells	
22	Fargo is a citizen of South Dakota. (<u>Id.</u>) However, this argument, and	
23	the other arguments Wells Fargo makes in support of its removal, are	
24	unpersuasive in light of the exhaustive analysis of the same issues in	
25	Taheny v. Wells Fargo Bank, N.A., 878 F. Supp. 2d 1093 (E.D. Cal. 2012),	
26		
27	v. Wells Fargo Bank, N.A., No. 2:12-cv-02024-GEB-CKD, 2012 WL 4961696,	
28	at *1-2 (E.D. Cal. Oct. 15, 2012) (B	Burrell, J.) (following Taheny and

3 Since both Plaintiff and Wells Fargo are citizens of 4 California, the Court is without subject matter jurisdiction, and this 5 case is remanded to the Superior Court of the State of California in the 6 County of Solano.
