Neither party has filed 22 23 objections to the findings and recommendations. The court has reviewed the file and finds the findings and recommendations to be 24 25 supported by the record and by the magistrate judge's analysis. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY 26 ORDERED that: 27 1. The findings and recommendations filed January 22, 2018, are adopted in full; 28 2. Plaintiff's motion to file a supplemental complaint (ECF No. 78) is denied; and 1

3. Defendants' motion for summary judgment (ECF No. 77) is granted as to the claim that defendant Scotland conspired to violate plaintiff's right to practice his religion in violation of the Bane Act; defendants' motion is denied in all other respects.
