




1 portion of Plaintiffs' motion seeking a preliminary injunction is  
2 denied.

3 Further, Plaintiffs' conclusory statements in their request do  
4 not demonstrate that they have a probability of succeeding on the merits  
5 of their claims, or that they risk suffering irreparable harm if an  
6 injunction does not issue. A & M Records, Inc. v. Napster, Inc., 239  
7 F.3d 1004, 1013 (9th Cir. 2001) (discussing injunction standard).  
8 Therefore, Plaintiffs' motion for a temporary restraining order (ECF No.  
9 2) is denied.
