

452, 454 (9th Cir. 1983). In his objections, Hafeez requests a 180-day stay of the case to obtain counsel. (ECF No. 32.) However, even if the court were to consider Hafeez's untimely objections, plaintiff's request to stay the action should be denied, because, for the reasons outlined by the magistrate judge in the findings and recommendations, Hafeez lacks statutory and constitutional standing to pursue his claim. The court has reviewed the applicable legal standards and, good cause appearing, concludes that it is appropriate to adopt the findings and recommendations in full. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that: 1. The findings and recommendations filed August 9, 2013 (ECF No. 31) are ADOPTED. 2. The United States' motion to strike (ECF Nos. 20, 24) is GRANTED. 3.
