23 This Order modifying the Court's Scheduling Orders (Docket Nos. 43 & 54) and [1]
 24 extending the date for disclosure of expert witnesses and [2] setting a deadline for the completion
 25 of expert discovery (the "**Order**") is made pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 16(b)(4)
 26 and Rule 26 and is based on the Stipulation dated December 24, 2014 between Plaintiffs Kristi
 27 Verma ("**Kristi**"), Vishal Verma ("**Vishal**"), and Zentek Corporation ("**Zentek**") (collectively
 28

1 “**Plaintiffs**”), on the one hand, and Defendants Efrat Okev (“**Efrat**”), Lloyd Burton (“**Lloyd**”),
2 and Augzenta, Inc. (“**Augzenta**”) (collectively “**Defendants**”) on the other hand (Plaintiffs and
3 Defendants collectively referred to as the “**Parties**”) with respect to the following recitals of fact:

4 **RECITALS**

5 A. The deadline for disclosure of expert witnesses is currently set for December 29,
6 2014.

7 B. The Parties have submitted a Stipulation that proposes new dates for expert
8 disclosure and discovery and confirms the Parties are in settlement negotiations and that
9 continuance of the deadlines would further the possibility of settlement and will not result in the
10 continuance of any other deadlines if negotiations are not successful.


11 In light of the information provided in the Stipulation, the court finds good cause for
12 continuing the deadlines as requested, and accordingly:

13 **IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

- 14 1. The date for the Parties to make their expert disclosures in accordance with Rule
15 26(a)(2) is extended to February 13, 2015.
- 16 2. All expert discovery shall be completed by March 27, 2015.
- 17 3. All other pretrial and trial deadlines shall remain unchanged.
