1 On January 29, 2014, this Court issued an order (“Order”) granting Defendants’, California
2 Bureau of Private Post Secondary Education, California Department of Consumer Affairs, Connie
3 Bouvia, Laura Metune, Julissa Silva-Garcia, and Russ Heimerich (“State Defendants”), Motion to
4 Dismiss, with leave to amend, ECF No. 28. See ECF No. 90. The Order provided that, if
5 Plaintiff, Xanthi Gionis (“Plaintiff”), did not file an amended complaint within thirty (30) days of
6 the Order, the causes of action against State Defendants would be dismissed with prejudice ECF
7 No. 90. Thirty (30) days expired on February 28, 2014. Thereafter, on March 4, 2014, the Court
