1 The parties to the above-captioned action submit this stipulation of joint proposed
2 briefing schedule and proposed order pursuant to the January 6, 2020 Order requiring the parties

- 10 a. Plaintiffs shall file a motion for summary judgment and supporting memorandum not
11 to exceed twenty-five pages (25) on or before September 4, 2020.
- 12 b. Federal Defendants shall file a cross motion for summary judgment and combined
13 memorandum in support and opposition to Plaintiffs’ motion for summary judgment
14 not to exceed thirty-five pages (35) on or before October 9, 2020.
- 15 c. Defendant-Intervenor shall file a cross motion for summary judgment and combined
16 memorandum in support and opposition to Plaintiffs’ motion for summary judgment
17 not to exceed thirty-five pages (35) on or before October 23, 2020.
- 18 d. Plaintiffs shall file their combined reply in support of their motion for summary
19 judgment and response to Federal Defendants’ cross motion for summary judgment
20 not to exceed twenty (20) pages on or before November 6, 2020.
- 21 e. Plaintiffs shall file their combined reply in support of their motion for summary
22 judgment and response to Defendant-Intervenor’s cross motion for summary
23 judgment not to exceed twenty (20) pages on or before November 20, 2020.
