See ECF No. 8. Plaintiff was informed that failure to comply with the court's order would 21 result in the dismissal of this matter without prejudice pursuant to Federal Rules of Civil 22 Procedure 41(b). Review of the Inmate Locator website operated by the California Department of 23 Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) indicates that plaintiff remains incarcerated at California State Prison-Sacramento (CSP-SAC), where the court's order was served on plaintiff. However, 24 25 plaintiff has not responded to the court's order, and time for doing so has expired. 26 See http://inmatelocator.cdcr.ca.gov/search.aspx. See also Fed. R. Evid. 201 (court may take 27 judicial notice of facts that are capable of accurate determination by sources whose accuracy 28 cannot reasonably be questioned).

1	Accordingly, this matter is dismissed without prejudice. <u>See</u> Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b).
